Champagne

Dom Pérignon, Épernay (2) **£145.00**

Arguably the greatest prestige Champagne in the world, this iconic Champagne was conceived as a tribute to the legendary blind Benedictine monk Dom Pérignon who was cellar master of the Abbey at Hautvillers and famously said that he could 'taste the stars' in Champagne. The first vintage dates back to 1921 and the wine continues to be made only in the finest vintages.

Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé, Tours-sur-Marne, France (2) **£79.00**

Presented in an elegant wine bottle inspired by King Henri IV, this Rosé Champagne has been widely acknowledged for its consistent high quality for more than 40 years.

Taittinger Brut Réserve NV (2) **Bottle £42.00**
Taittinger Brut Réserve NV (2) **Half bottle £24.00**

Simply put, Taittinger Brut Réserve defines the Taittinger house style. It is assembled from more than 35 crus and incorporates 40% Chardonnay – this high level is seldom offered in a non-vintage Champagne. Dry, light and graceful with small, fine bubbles. Fresh citrus fruit and subtle, weightier notes of peach and brioche combine to provide elegance in a glass.

Taittinger Brut Prestige Rosé NV (2) **£45.00**

This is a vibrant rosé with a vivid aroma of red summer fruit. Enticing wild strawberry and raspberry characters dominate the stylish and elegant palate.

Taittinger Nocturne Sec NV (4) **£45.00**

Exciting and beautifully balanced Champagne with twice the dosage of the Brut Réserve, this tiny touch of sweetness makes for a soft and mellow wine that is perfect to drink at night.

Taittinger Comtes de Champagne
Blanc de Blancs Brut Vintage (2) **£115.00**

100% Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes from the finest vineyards in the Côte des Blancs and only produced in great vintages, this is produced in very limited quantities and aged slowly between 8 and 10 years deep underground in their 4th century Roman cellars.

Taittinger Brut Vintage (2) **£52.00**

Taittinger Vintage is an elegant but complex cuvée made from a blend of 50% Chardonnay primarily from the Grands Crus of the Côte des Blancs and 50% Pinot Noir primarily from the Grands Crus of the Montagne de Reims at the start of the Vallée de la Marne. Whilst still showing the elegance and sophistication that is the Taittinger style, the vintage offers more weight and body with nutty characters, excellent concentration and a long, full-flavoured finish.

Sparkling

Prosecco Superiore DOCG Asolo Col Vittorio (2) **£25.00**

A fine Prosecco from the smaller of the two DOCG zones. Made from vineyards surrounding Asolo, the 'city of a hundred horizons', it is the epitome of class and pleasure.

Non alcoholic wine

Torres Natureo Muscat, Penedès, Spain (3) **£17.95**

This de-alcoholised white wine from the Torres winery in Spain is made from Muscat grapes. Fresh and fruity on the palate, it has 0.5% alcohol making it a great apéritif.

Torres Natureo Syrah, Penedès, Spain (B) **£17.95**

A lovely cherry colour with aromas of pomegranate and redcurrant.



White Wine

Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand (2) **£45.00**

One of the most prestigious Sauvignon Blancs in the world, Cloudy Bay was created in 1985 in the Wairau Valley in Marlborough. A wine full of fresh herbal aromas and layers of ripe guava and tropical fruit which is succulent and crisp.

Charles Smith Kung Fu Girl Riesling, Washington State, USA (2) **£32.00**

This outstanding Riesling is smooth and aromatic with zesty citrus and stone fruit flavours.

Flint Dry, Chapel Down, Tenterden, Great Britain (2) **£27.00**

A great introduction to quality English wine, this fruit-driven white wine is an ideal alternative to aromatic white wines such as Sauvignon Blanc or Pinot Grigio. This wine is characterised by crisp aromas of ripe apple, grass and citrus zest.

Gavi di Gavi, Figini, La Chiara, Piedmont, Italy (2) **£28.00**

Gavi has become one of the most sought-after premium Italian wines. This renowned wine is made from the Cortese grape in Piedmont and offers delicious mineral elegance and fresh orchard fruit flavours with real finesse.

Chardonnay Reserve, Tooma River, Warburn Estate, South Eastern Australia (2) **£22.00**

This wine is packed with grapefruit, lime and melon flavours, with a zesty, citrus acidity which cuts through to the finish.

Chablis, Domaine de Biéville, France (1) **£40.00**

Notes of mineral and citrus on the nose are followed by a crisp, dry and acidic palate with a clean citrus and stone notes.

Pinot Grigio, Puiattino, Giovanni Puiatti, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy (1) **£24.00**

Giovanni Puiatti's father Vittorio developed what is now Italy's dominant white wine-making technique, frequently called the "Metodo Puiatti". Using 100% stainless steel throughout fermentation and ageing brings a super clean steely style with fresh grassy notes and hints of green apples. The palate has a touch of honeyed richness but is fresh and crisp.

Rosé Wine

Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Tissier, France (2) **£30.00**

The Tissier vineyards lie in the heart of Sancerre. Production is small, and the family aim to produce high quality Rosé from 100% Pinot Noir.

Zinfandel Rosé, West Coast Swing, California (5) **£22.00**

Full of ripe fruit aromas such as peaches, mango and melon. Juicy on the palate with strawberry and tropical fruit flavours with fresh acidity balancing the sweetness.

Red Wine

Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba, Fontanafredda, Piedmont, Italy (D) **£70.00**

Deep red with ruby highlights, this superb Barolo has a clear-cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices, withered roses and underbrush. The palate is dry, but soft, full-bodied, velvety and well-balanced.

Charles Smith Velvet Devil Merlot, Walla Walla, Washington State, USA (C) **£36.00**

Aromas and flavours of ripe dark cherries, chocolate and tobacco over a lush texture.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cannonball, Sonoma County, USA (D) **£38.00**

Californian Cabernet at its finest. Balance in the mouth is exceptional from start to finish – strawberry, blueberry and red apple dipped in dark chocolate, all-spice and a layer of toasted oak. You can be assured that this wine will deliver a serious splash!

Corney & Barrow Saint-Émilion, France (E) **£42.00**

Founded in 1780, Corney & Barrow has used centuries of experience to seek out the best producers to bottle under its own label. This is a Merlot-dominated blend, soft and warming from one of the most famous wine regions in the world.

The High Trellis Cabernet Sauvignon, d'Arenberg, McLaren Vale, Australia (E) **£30.00**

Made from grapes handpicked from high trellises in the McLaren Vale, this has ripe blackcurrant and mint aromas and flavours.

Wirra Wirra Church Block, McLaren Vale, Australia (E) **£38.00**

A classic Australian blend of Cabernet, Shiraz and Merlot from the McLaren Vale. The Church Block is named after a small parcel of vines next to the 19th century church at Bethany.

Malbec, Aruma, Mendoza, Argentina (C) **£30.00**

Sourced from the Catena family's high-altitude vineyards in Maipú, Lujan de Cuyo, Tupungato and San Carlos, this Malbec has dense black-fruit aromatics and a smooth, lengthy finish that has become the family's trademark characteristic.
